

# Accident injures three

Three persons were admitted to Chestnut Hill Hospital following a one-car collision Monday afternoon on Mermaid Lane, Wyndmoor.

Springfield police said the accident occurred as a car driven by Marie Little Ashmead, E. Sedgwick Street, Philadelphia, was heading east on Mermaid Lane. The accident occurred near the Pine Road intersection.

The Ashmead car left the road, said investigators, jumped the curb and ran over a street sign. It struck a utility pole and traveled about 30 feet before striking another pole and coming to a

stop, officers said. In addition to Ashmead, two passengers, Edith J. and Henry Farquhar, Ardmore Avenue, Wyndmoor, were also injured.

Henry Farquhar was extricated from the rear of the vehicle by members of the Springfield and Ambler Community Ambulance Association.

Ashmead and Henry Farquhar were admitted to the intensive care unit and listed in guarded condition Tuesday afternoon.

Edith Farquhar was listed in stable condition.
