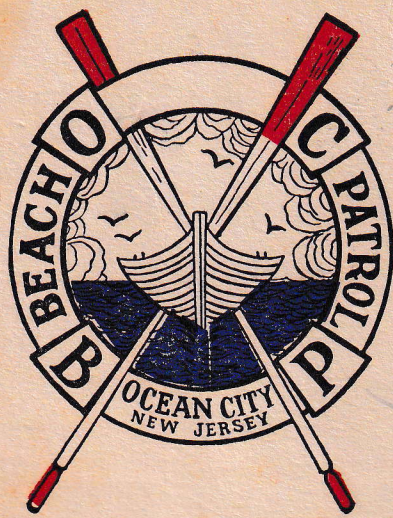

THE JOHN B. KELLY TROPHIES

IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE, MR. KELLY PLACED TWO FINE TROPHIES THAT MUST BE WON THREE CONSCUTIVE YEARS, BY ANY ONE BOAT CREW, OR INDIVIDUAL. THE FIRST INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS SUCCESSFUL IN OBTAINING ONE OF THESE TROPHIES WAS JOE REGAN, IN THE YEAR 1946; LEAVING THE ONE REMAINING TROPHY.

GEO. WEISSBERG WHO IS NOW ROWING WITH JAMES SUNDSTROM HAS TWO OF THE NECESSARY CLAIMS ON THE REMAINING TROPHY. IF HE SHOULD BE VICTORIOUS THIS YEAR HE WILL RETAIN THIS TROPHY AS JOE. REGAN DID IN 1946.

MR. KELLY ALSO DONATES INDIVIDUAL TROPHIES TO THE WINNING TEAMS OF FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD PLACES YEARLY.



HISTORY OF THE OCEAN CITY BEACH PATROL

The Ocean City Beach Patrol was first headed by Captain Alfred R. Smith before the first World War when it changed hands several times until Nineteen Twenty when it was made an organized Beach Patrol under the direction of Captain Jack G. Jernee who retired in Nineteen Forty-two. Captain Thos. A. Williams who started as a guard in 1922 and advanced to Lieutenant in 1935, later taking full charge in 1942. The Ocean City Beach Patrol is considered one of the finest on the Atlantic Coast with no drownings at protected beaches for twenty-seven years.

The seven miles of beach are manned by fifty-five guards, placed at the most strategic points along the beach.

The duties of a guard consist of taking care of a hundred to a hundred and fifty bathers daily, and the Patrol handles over fifteen hundred first-aid cases per year such as splinters, shock, sun cases, etc.

The guards are tutored in swimming rescue work, artificial respiration and handling of boats, so that they may give the most efficient service that can be rendered.
