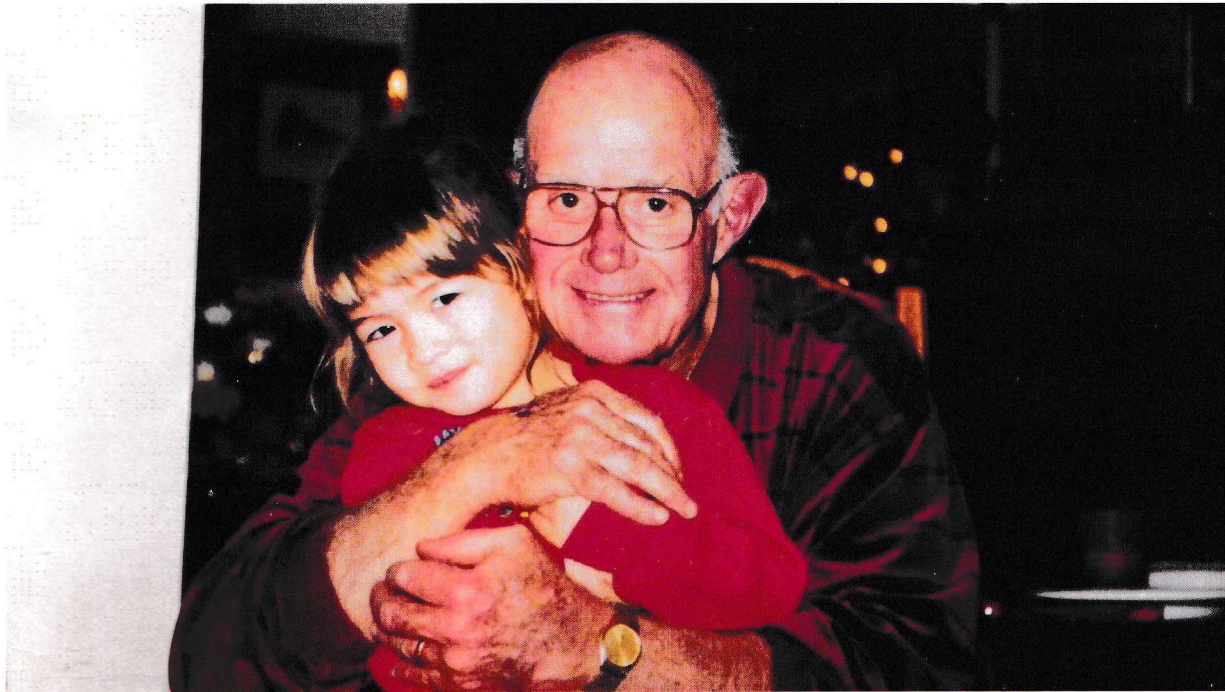

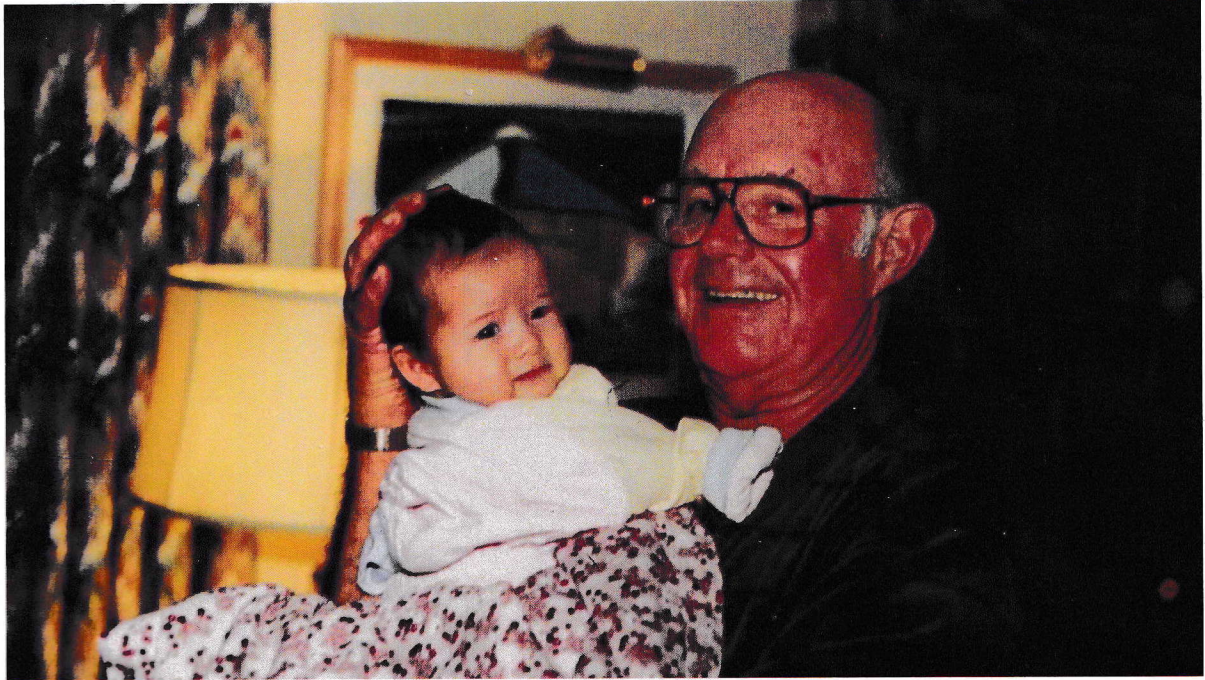
PopPop~

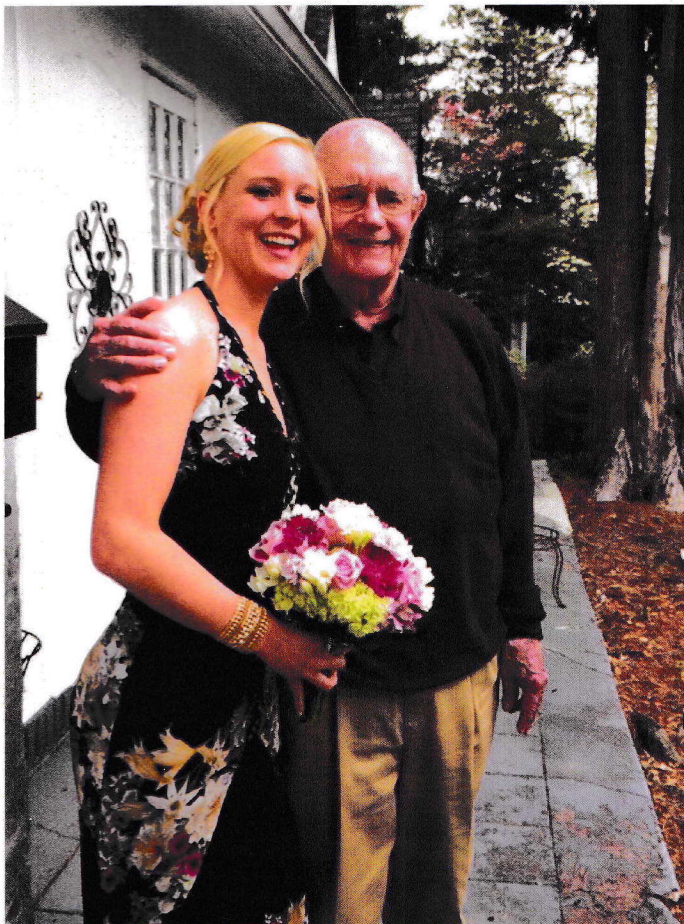


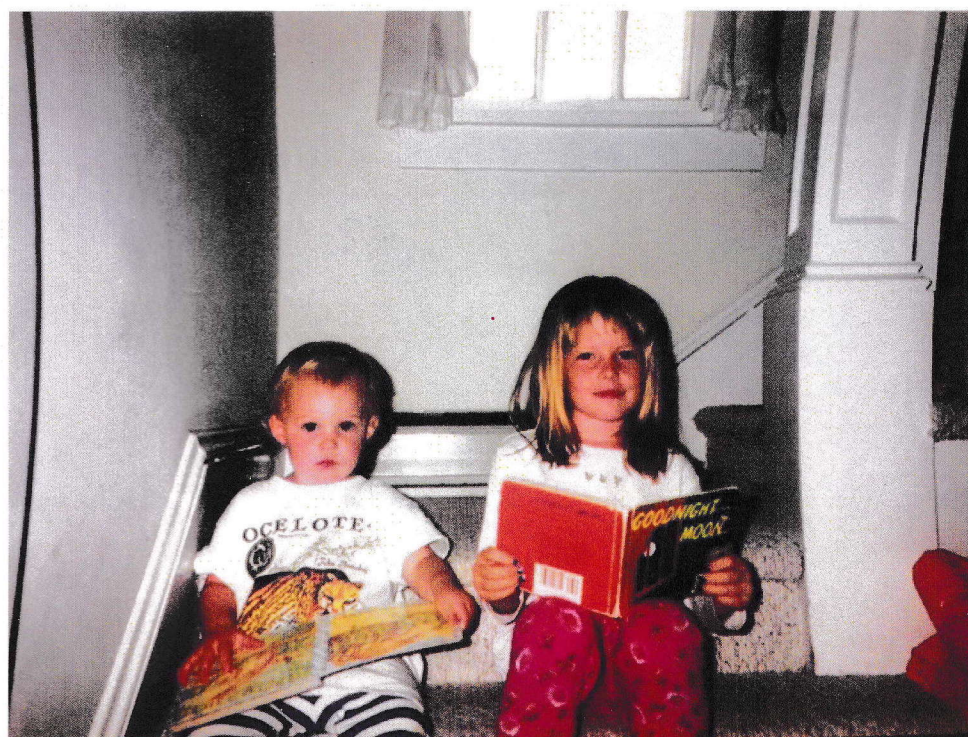
Julia (aka Mouse)

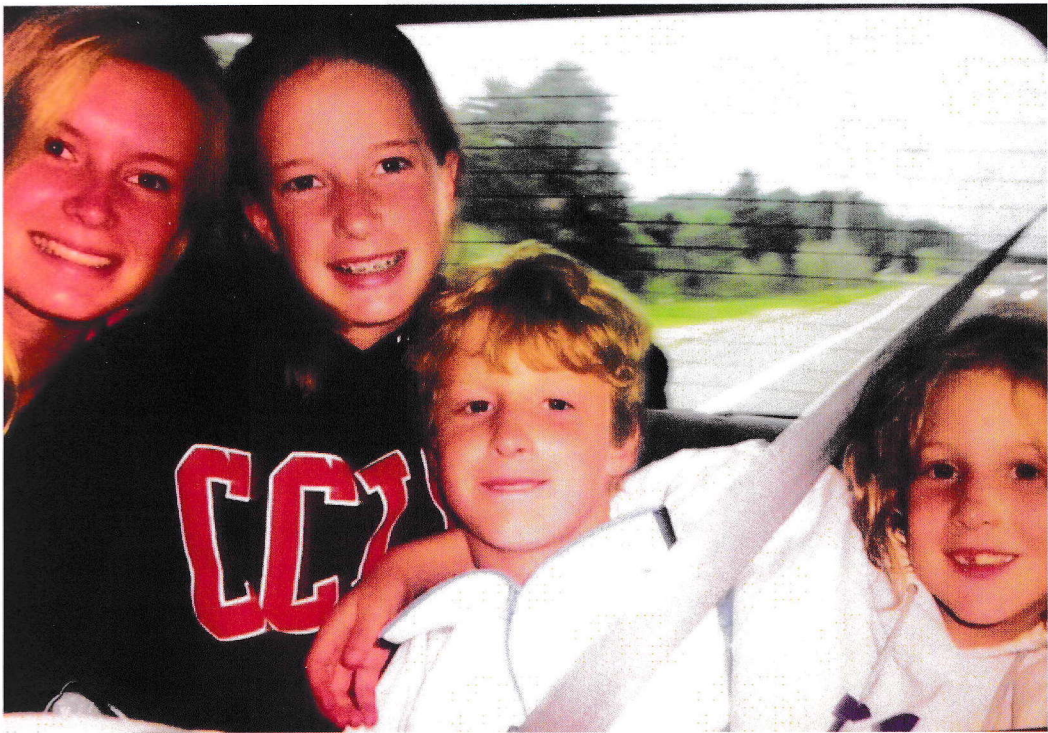
Pop pop,

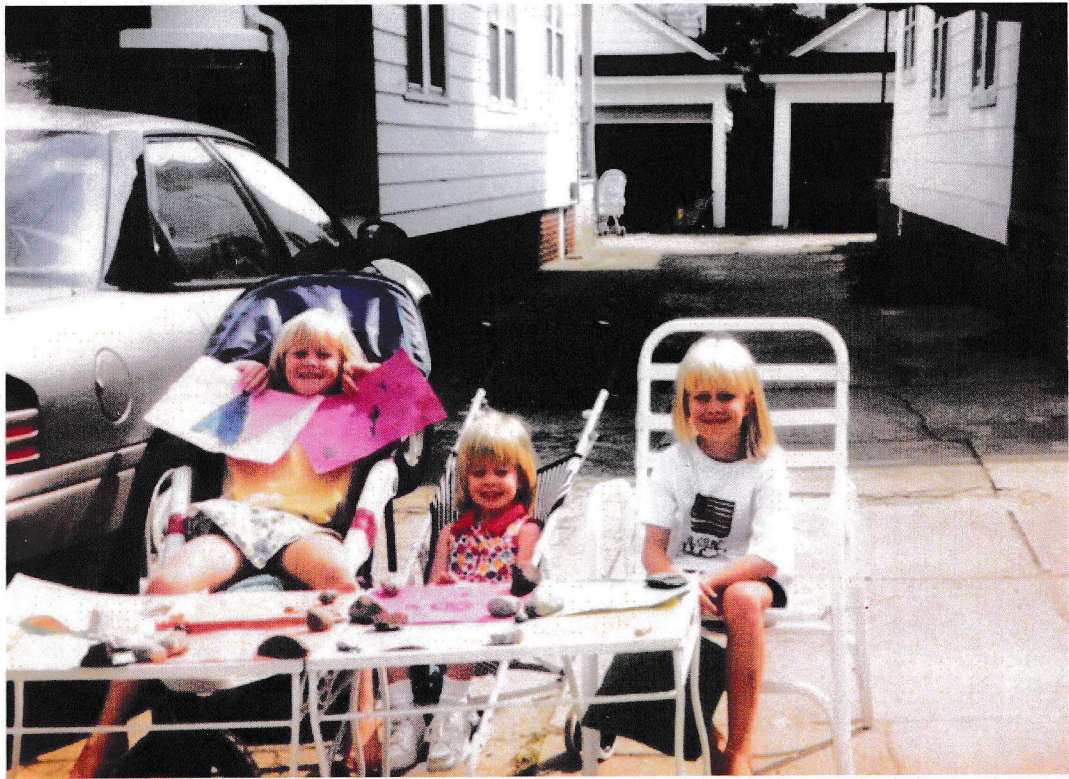
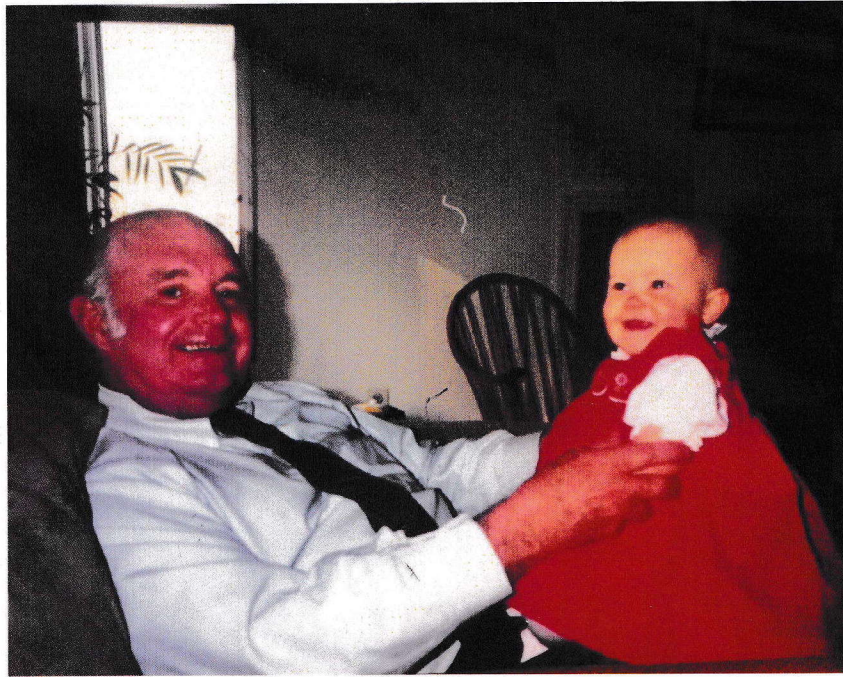
PopPop,

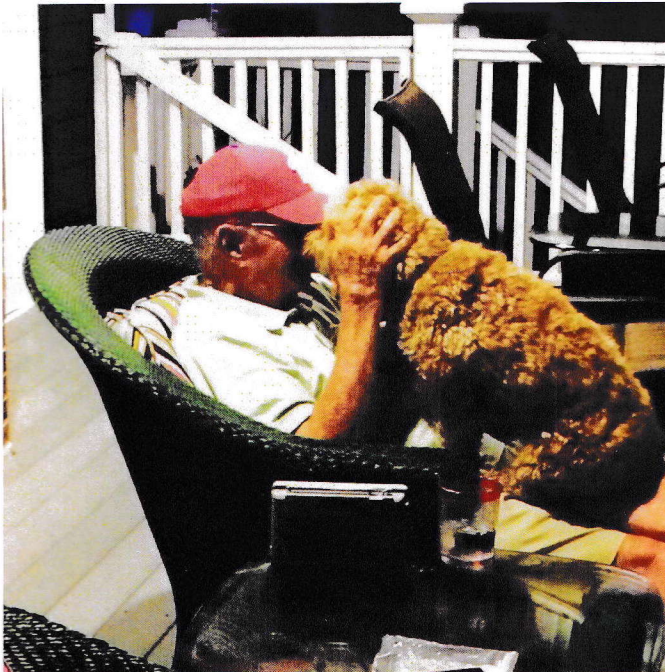




Tim
